CHINA: Wang Dao, persecuted pastor

CSW (Christian Solidarity Worldwide) takes up the case of persecuted pastor, **Wang Dao**, leader of the growing church in Guangzhou province, who has been in and out of prison. The church had recently secured a twelve-month lease to hold services in a local hotel, but it was terminated in August after just one month.

Traidcraft have been able to continue to work amongst the Aids victims, and although the work remains small due to harassment, it provides a lifeline to those who it reaches. They need our prayers, and our continued support. The Pakistani suppliers of Mountain Fruits---Apricots and Flame Raisins ---- remain in great need. Their community is cut off, and they have limited food and power supplies. They need our prayers too. Praise God that Traidcraft are in this for the long term, and that they will continue to help in the rebuilding of both these projects, long after the Media and the Super Markets have given up and gone home.
